INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE TOURNAMENT ARE AS FOLLOWS:

The following 2010-2011 National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) rules will be used with format modifications:

- Libero – will be allowed under the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) rules, providing they have a uniform that is clearly contrasting from the other team players.

FORMAT:

Pool Play & Re-Seed Rounds

- Match - each match will consist of two games, rally scored, of 25 points, cap of 27 points.
- Each team will be allowed one 60-second timeout per game.

Tie-Breaker:

- head-to-head match
- total pool points
- coin toss

Re-Seed Round:

- The teams will be re-seeded based on won-loss record following the conclusion of pool play.
- Top team in each pool will be placed in Pool AA
- Second place team will be placed in Pool BB
- Third place team will be placed in Pool CC
- Fourth place team will be placed in Pool DD
- Fifth place team will be placed in Pool EE

Championship or "X" Round:

The championship round will be single elimination in their respective bracket. Each match will be one game to 25 points, deuce, no cap, one 60-second timeout. We will switch sides at 13 points.

- The first match will start promptly at 5:00 PM on Friday, August 13, 2010.
- JV teams and Pool D of the Varsity/Blue division will play at Farrington High School.
- Pool A, B and C of the Varsity/Blue division will play at McKinley High School.

Saturday, August 14, 2010

- The first match will start promptly at 8:00 AM
- JV teams will play at Farrington High School
- All Varsity/Blue division teams will play at McKinley High School

Sunday, August 15, 2010 (Playoffs & Championships)

- The first match will start promptly at 8:00 AM.
- All Varsity/Blue division teams will play at McKinley High School

WARM-UPS:

- There will be 4 minutes shared, or 2 minutes each team.
- NO SHARED HITTING IS ALLOWED.
- NO DIGGING ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE IS ALLOWED.
- The time between games is three minutes.

OFFICIALS

The OIVOA will provide top officials. (If there are not enough officials available, the teams will provide). The teams are required to provide an umpire, scorekeeper, and two line judges.
